Over the years Dr. Lee has worked in several health care facilities including multidisciplinary clinics and a clinic specialized in musculoskeletal care. Dr. Lee teaches two classes in the chiropractic curriculum at Texas Chiropractic College and is an attending clinician in the Moody Health Care Center since 1996. In addition, Dr. Lee is faculty advisor for the Council on Sports Medicine club at Texas Chiropractic College.

John Nash, DC, earned his Chiropractic degree from Texas Chiropractic College and began practice in Houston, Texas. In addition, Dr. Nash joined the faculty of Texas Chiropractic College and had the opportunity to combine his sports interests by developing a sports practice with nearby San Jacinto College. In 1994, he was chosen as the sixth member of the ACA Sports Council Hall of Fame. His lectures have taken him across the US, into Central America, the Canary Islands, and Europe. He has served as a Chief Examiner for Part IV National Board from its inception to the present.

Exam cost is \$350, and will be payable to ACBSP. **Under Wisconsin Law, completion of this program allows you to use CCSP as a credential.**
